Dear Parents:

Welcome to Camp Gan Israel! By joining our camp you will be giving your child/children the opportunity to experience an exciting and meaningful summer program with many other Jewish children from the Las Vegas area.

Online registration will open on February 1, 2019 at cgilasvegas.com./registration Hard copies of the registration form are also available on the website.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The camp dates are June 24—August 2, 2019. Camp is in session Monday through Friday 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Please make sure that your child/children are dropped off and picked up on time. Parents will not be allowed to remain at camp headquarters after 9:00 am as this interferes with the camp program.
2. The cost for camp is \$225.00 per week. or \$1250.00 for the entire summer. This amount is further discounted to \$1100 if paid in full by March 1, 2019. Weekly payments are due on Monday of each week. The charge for boys entering sixth grade and up, enrolled in the Gan Israel Cyclers program is \$240 per week. **Please note: The cyclist program runs for 4 weeks only, from June 24—July 19.** Girl pioneers (entering fifth grade and up) pay the regular price for camp, but will be charged an additional fee for overnights..
3. Early childcare will be provided form 8:00—9:00 am and aftercare from 3:00 —4:00 pm. There is an additional cost of \$5.00 per hour per child.
4. Camp is located at Desert Torah Academy, 1312 Vista Dr. The children should be dropped off at this location. Drop off is between 8:45 –9:00 am. Children should report to the gym. If you are coming into the building, please park in a designated parking spot. Parents should park and come into the gym to pick their children up at the end of the day.
5. Every camper must have a camp shirt (hats are optional). It is mandatory for campers to wear camp shirts on trip days. Shirts are available for purchase in the office. They cost \$10.

6. Children should bring a dairy or pareve lunch, a drink and an icepack, if needed, in a labeled lunch bag. **Meat lunches are not allowed.** An optional hot lunch program will be offered on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays. You may purchase lunches for your children on those days for \$5 per lunch.
7. All campers and staff members must wear long, short or cap sleeve shirts. No halter tops or tank tops are allowed. Boys should wear a kippah or hat to camp every day.
8. At the end of each week, you will receive a detailed schedule of the next week's camp activities. Generally, all campers will be going swimming three times a week. The older campers will be swimming at a pool on premises, with a certified lifeguard supervising. The younger groups will be swimming in wading pools. On swim days please send along a swimsuit, towel and sunscreen with your child's name in a labeled bag.
9. The children will be going on field trips each week. On the larger trips we will be chartering a bus; on smaller trips we will be using the camp van and parent carpool. Children under the age of six and weighing less than 60 pounds must bring their car seats and/or booster seats for the field trips in which we will not be using a charter bus. You will be notified in advance of such trips. Toddler bunks do not go on trips.
10. Late night and overnight programs for older campers will be arranged. You will be notified in advance.
11. Please be aware that camp communicates with parents largely via email. Whenever you see an email from camp, be sure to read it carefully as it may contain important information. Once camp starts, please inform the office immediately if you are not receiving emails.
